

Minimum Pay Bonus

If the base pay plus the tip on the reservation is less than 30%, then the minimum pay bonus will pay the difference.

For example, you do a \$120 trip, tax was \$8, tolls are \$0, and fuel was \$10. After removing the tax and fuel, the amount you get paid on is \$102. If the base pay plus the tip on the reservation was \$28.60, then the minimum pay bonus will pay an additional \$2.

Why a minimum pay bonus? Even though you are a contractor, we want to make sure your pay both ways is at least \$15 per hour even if the customer does not give you a cash tip. Customers can remove a tip on the reservation if they are unhappy, but this is rare. Generally, with cash tips drivers make about \$20 per hour on the low end; this includes extra time for car washes and pumping gas.
